REJECTION OF BIDS

The undersigned agrees that the County reserves the right to reject any or all bids, and reserves the right to waive informalities in a bid or bids, not affected by law, if to do so seems to best serve the public interest.

VALIDITY OF BIDS

The undersigned agrees that this bid will remain valid for sixty (60) days after the scheduled bid opening.

STATE LICENSES

The undersigned hereby certifies that he is currently the holder of a valid Class "A" or "B" license as a contractor in the State of California and that the license is the correct class of license for the work described in the project drawings and specifications. INSURANCE

If a Contract is terminated according to this provision, the County is entitled to pursue any available legal remedies.


