The following changes and/or additions shall be made to the plans and/or specifications. All other requirements of the contract documents shall remain the same. The Bidder shall acknowledge receipt of the addendum by inserting its number and date in the Bid Proposal.

Pre-Proposal Questions and Answers:

Q1: Will the modular be provided by owner or we have to purchase?

A1: Contractor to purchase and install the modular building as called out in plans.

Q2: Is the engineer value \$265,500?

A2: Revised engineering Cost is \$322,465 instead of \$265,500.

Q3: 1. The type of construction (VB) and the occupancy group (B) for the modular building combined with the distance between the adjacent buildings being greater than 10 feet means that CBC does NOT require exterior walls to be rated. Not rated wall would obviously be less expensive. Does the county still want the walls to be rated? If so then the windows and door will need to be rated and those called out will not work within 1-hr assembly.

A3: We agree that fire rated walls and openings are not required based on 2016 CBC, table 602. However, the General Contractor shall submit the engineered drawings and specs to the City of Rancho Cucamonga Building and Safety Services Department (as a deferred submittal) for review and approval. If the exterior walls are for some reason required to be rated, the windows and doors shall be rated as well per Prefab Building Manuf.'s recommendations.

Information: Omit Key Note #1 on sheet A1.1. Please do not include this item in your bid since the tree has already been removed.
